The Peace Tanabata Festival

“The Peace Tanabata Festival” is the program that the 3 Menettes Clubs in Sendai have been involved in for many years. Since the day of the Sendai Tanabata Festival, one of the three major festivals in the northeastern region of Japan, takes place on August 6, the same day as the atomic bomb was dropped in Hiroshima, they thought that their appeal of the tragedy in Hiroshima at the Tanabata Festival could help the public become more aware of atomic bombs and that the appeal would not let the memories of the tragedy fade away. For that purpose, the club members started making streamers of thousands of origami paper cranes in 1976 to decorate the scenes of the festival. Since then, they receive over one million origami cranes from all over the country every year. During this Asia Pacific Area Convention, participants will be welcomed by the streamers of the Peace Tanabata Festival made with the origami cranes contributed by Y's Menettes from all over Japan.
